To be held under The M C U I General Competition Rules, the Standing Regulation for Trials and these: **SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS:**

1. The trial is open to all grades: Each section will have 3 lines, hard standard and easy. Competitors can choose whatever line they feel comfortable with.

When moving from the paddock to the arena riders must dismount and push their bikes to the arena. There will be a lot of spectators in this area and the public must be protected. Riding of bikes will only be permitted inside the arena.
Safety helmets must be worn as per M.C.U.I (UC) LTD regulations.

4. A parc- ferme will be used before the event begins. All fuel must be brought to this area as access to the paddock will be restricted once the event starts.

5. Photographs may be taken and displayed on the internet or newspaper.

6. Incorporated into this event will be a separate "**King of the Step**" competition. This events starts at 7.30 its open to all competitors already competing in the trial. Each rider will take turns to get over a step in the middle of the arena. To progress to the next round the rider must get up the step feet up and without any assistance. Each rider will have 3 attempts. After each round is complete the height of the step is increased and all remaining riders will have three more attempts at this new height. This process is repeated until one rider is remaining and they will be crowned King of the step. For the King of the Step competition we will have a cash prize of 1st £100, 2nd £50 3rd £25.

7.
